Douzelage Young Musician of the Year (M4EU) 2018

This festival is for Teenage young musicians from across Europe. It will consist of Master classes, a competition and concert, as well as social activities. One participant per discipline will be chosen to represent Sherborne in this prestigious event.

Rules are stated below for applicants who wish to apply.

Closing Date for applications: 8th December 2017

Classes: Woodwind, Brass, Strings and Piano

Eligibility: You must be resident, or in full time education, within Sherborne **urban or rural area**.

Age: Participants must be in school years 11 – 13 or aged up to 14 - 18 years on 30th October 2017.

Qualification: You should have achieved at least ABRSM grade 6 or equivalent.

Application: You must submit a completed application form, copy of your certificate or a letter from your teacher saying that you are of the appropriate standard, together with a recording of you playing.

Registration fee: Registration is free.

Costs: Accommodation, meals and travel are free to successful applicants.

Prizes and Awards: There will be certificates for all and a trophy for the overall winner

Participants must be available to travel to and stay in France from 1st – 6th July, return may have to be on 7th.

Location: Granville, Normandy, France

Performance Requirements: One or more pieces can be played within the time allowed to show the range and quality of your ability. A recording (MP3) of you playing the pieces that you have selected must be made available for the adjudicators. The address is on the application form

Accompanist: You may use an accompanist, but must name that person on your application form.

Music duration: The music recording must be between 10 minutes and up to a maximum of 15minutes duration. Longer pieces will not be accepted.
